

1ST ANNUAL FRAG SWAP JUNE 12, 2005 2-4PM

You are invited to the first annual (yes, it's redundant) MARS Frag Swap on June 12th from 2-4pm in Madison, WI. It is open to anyone who would like to attend. The location is 825 W. Badger Rd at Fire Station #6 community room. It's close to the beltline (Highway 12/18 in Madison), centrally located, and has lots of free parking.

What is a "frag swap"? As corals grow in reef aquariums, they can be cut or "fragged" to make a new animal - much in the same way a houseplant is split. A frag swap is simply a place for people with reef aquariums to meet and exchange pieces of coral. It's a good time and a good practice. By using a fragged coral, you are keeping ocean corals where they belong...in the ocean!



Guidelines for the swap:

- All are welcome to trade, sell or buy
- No commercial vendors please
- Pre-bagged frags and used equipment only
- As space is somewhat limited, no tanks or "frag boxes" please
- Traders please bring towels for cleanup
- There will be no electrical outlets available for setups
- Please pre-label your frags with name, light and current requirements - including a picture is always helpful
