

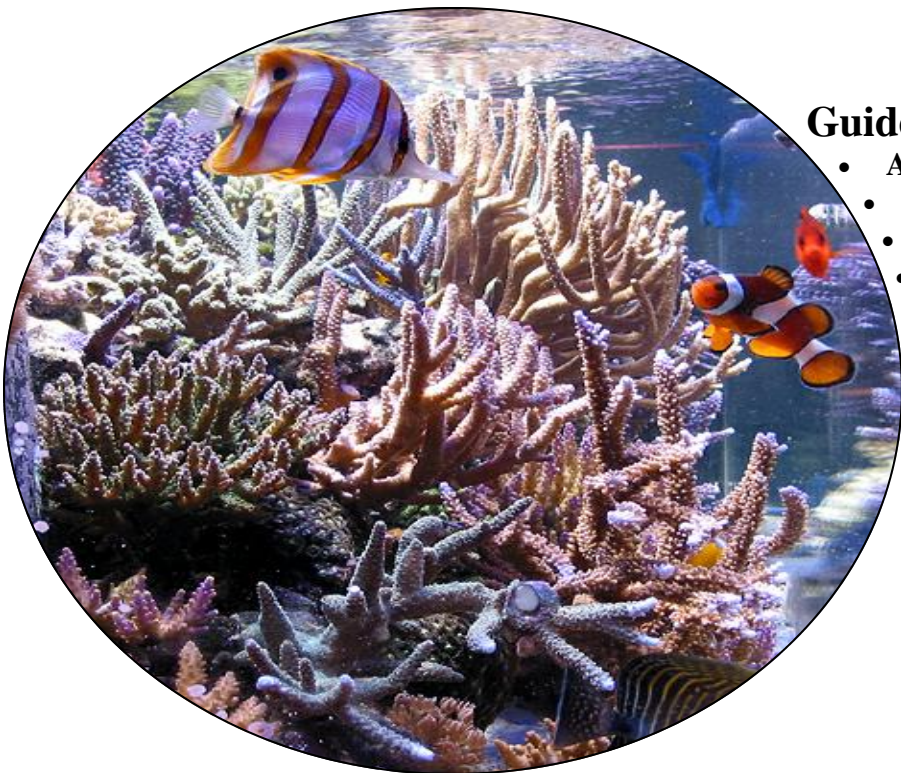

FRAG SWAP 2.0 JANUARY 22, 2006 12:30-4PM

You are invited to the MARS Frag Swap on January 22, 2006 from 12:30-4pm in Sun Prairie, WI (NE of Madison). It is open to anyone who would like to attend. The location is 1350 Linnerud Dr. in Sun Prairie at the Sun Prairie Public Library. Please visit the MARS website (www.madisonreef.com) for directions. Free parking. Fragging demo at 3:30pm—learn techniques and see the tools used for successful fragging of corals. Coral frags made at the demo will be given away afterwards!

What is a “frag swap”? As corals grow in reef aquariums, they can be cut or “fragged” to make a new animal - much in the same way a houseplant is split. A frag swap is simply a place for people with reef aquariums to meet and exchange pieces of coral. It’s a good time and a good practice. By using a fragged coral, you are keeping ocean corals where they belong...in the ocean!



Guidelines for the swap:

- All are welcome to trade, sell or buy
- Doors open for set up at 12:00pm (MARS Members)
- No commercial vendors please
- Pre-bagged frags and used equipment only
- Traders please bring towels for cleanup
- There will be electrical outlets available for setups (bring your own extension cord)
- Please pre-label your frags with name, light and current requirements - a picture is always helpful
